- 6 cups milk**
- 4 large, baking potatoes,
baked, peeled and cubed**
- 4 green onions, thinly sliced**
- 12 strips bacon, cooked and
crumbled**
- 2 cups shredded cheddar
cheese**
- 1 cup sour cream**
- ¾ teaspoon salt (optional)**
- ½ teaspoon pepper**

- 1. Cook the 12 strips of bacon
and put ½ cup of bacon
grease into a sauce pan.
(Crumble 12 strips of bacon
and save for later)**
- 2. Stir flour slowly into the
bacon grease and mix until
smooth and bubbly.

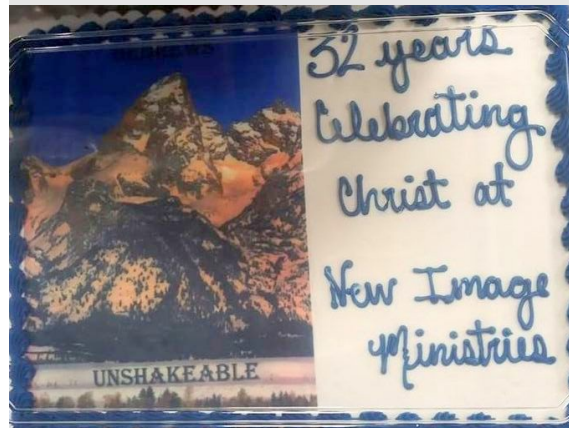
