

Balsamic-Roasted Brussels Sprouts

Makes 6 servings

Ingredients:

*1 ½ pounds Brussels Sprouts
cut in half through the core

*4 ounces pancetta, ¼ inch –
diced

You may use Bacon or pork
bellies with fat removed

In place of pancetta.

*1/4 c. good olive oil

*Kosher salt and freshly ground
black pepper

*1 tablespoon syrupy balsamic
vinegar

Directions:

Preheat the oven to 400 degrees.
Place the Brussels sprouts on a
sheet pan, including some of the
loose leaves, which get crispy
when they're roasted.

Add: pancetta, olive oil, 1 ½
teaspoons of salt, and ½
teaspoon of pepper, toss with
your hands, and spread out in a
single layer. Roast the Brussels
sprouts for 20 to 30 minutes, until
they're tender and nicely browned


