

Ingredients:
2 to 3 sticks of butter (Melted to room temperature)
2 to 3 cups flour
6 eggs (to be added one at a time)
3 Cups Swans Down Cake Flour (Sifted)
¼ pt of Heavy Whipping Cream
1 teaspoon vanilla
1 teaspoon Baking Powder

Instructions:
Lightly grease and flour a pound cake pan and put aside
Mix together butter that has been melted by sitting out
And sugar,
Add eggs, one at a time and mix well after each egg
Swift flour in slowly
Mix in Baking Powder
Vanilla
Whipping cream
Mix for approximately 5 minutes

Preheat oven to 325 degrees and bake.

** If it starts to brown, turn oven down to 300 degrees
Bake 1 hour and 20 minutes

ask."




I wanted to see joy and
