The radio announcement,

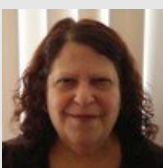
“We need you to “Fill His House with Glory” with the emphasis on

Think of every time God said no and we didn't understand why and later on down the road we realized that He saw the big picture and we did not.

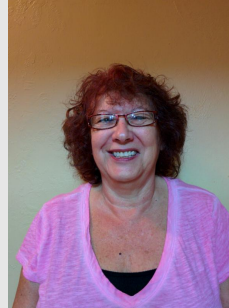
Times we need to stop and say "Thank You Lord".
