Greated Cheese to taste (optional)

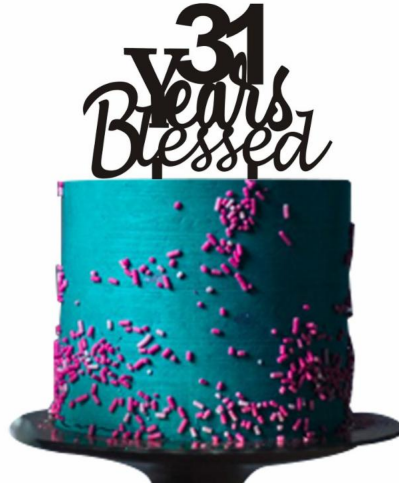
Put greated chicken into a large bowl (for mixing)
