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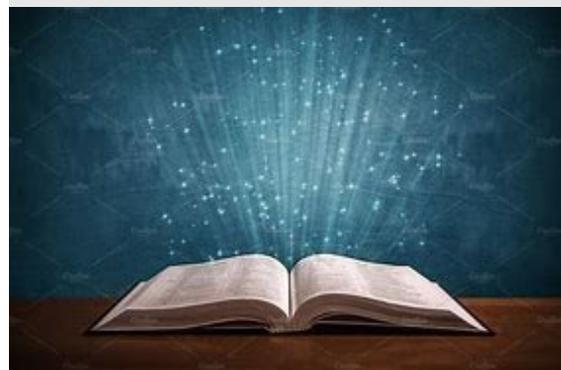
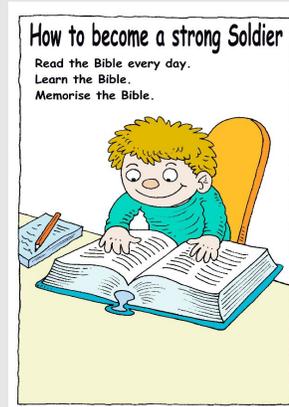
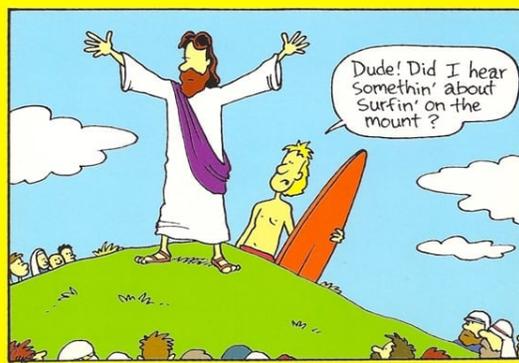
**Beef Wellington**

- 1 package of store bought Phyllo Dough - (Keep frozen until use)
- 3 – 5 pound - Round Beef Roast
- Thyme
- Rosemary
- Mushrooms
- Salt
- Pepper
- ¼ cup Olive Oil

\*Chop all and add to olive Oil

\*Cover and heat in micro wave for one

down on the Phyllo  
dough and wrap  
tightly  
Make sure the ends  
are wrapped first.  
Cut off any excess

to give you hope  
and a future.”

Put in oven 300 degrees for 3 hours. Let it set at least 30 minutes before slicing.



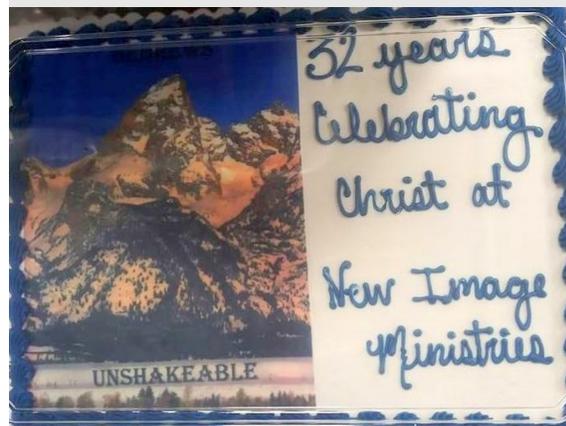
