I never have free time


My autobiography would be titled "My Own Sanity"

## Fried Green Tomatoes Submitted by Geraldine Patterson

Ingredients:

1 Cup Yellow Cornmeal

3/4 tablespoon – all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon sugar

1 teaspoon seasoned salt

1/4 teaspoon – cayenne pepper

1 cup – buttermilk

5 green tomatoes sliced

2 to 3 tablespoons of bacon drippings or vegetable oil **Dip** tomatoes in buttermilk

Combine cornmeal, flour, sugar, and seasonings
Coat both sides of the tomato slices with the mixture
Place on a wire rack and allow it to dry for ten
minutes.

In a large cast iron skillet, heat drippings or shortening over medium heat Fry tomatoes in a single layer Brown each side lightly

He doesn't hand out fancy gifts Like we would send to mother Instead He sends a message clear To always love each other.


He doesn't give me teddy bears That whimper, "please be mine" Instead He gave His heart to me I wear it all the time.




